EXTRACT DOGS NSW REGULATIONS

- 4.1 A dog shall only be eligible for registration in the associate register if:
- (a) it is ineligible for registration in the main register or the limited register;
 - (b) the dog has competed in or is to compete in and is likely to continue to compete in an obedience class or an obedience trial or a tracking trial or an agility trial or an agility test 1A which is conducted at a recognised show, and; **2/95**
 - (c) the owner is a member, and
 - (d) the dog has been desexed, and **2/95**
 - (e) There is submitted a duly completed Application for Registration in such form accompanied by such fee as the Board of Directors may from time to time require together with a Certificate from a Veterinary Surgeon confirming that the dog has been desexed.
