

Regulation Part 11 – Show, Section 21: Limitation of Exhibits for Judging, Clauses, 20.1B & 20.1C

Following is the Regulation prior to February 2021.

Regulation Part 11 Show Section 20 20.1B

20.1B At an Obedience Trial

- (i) 7 exhibits per hour in a Novice or Community Companion Dog Class with a maximum of 40 exhibits.
- (ii) 6 exhibits per hour in an Open Class with a maximum of 35 exhibits
- (iii) 5 exhibits per hour in a Utility Dog or Utility Dog Excellent Class with a maximum of 30 exhibits.
- (iv) Where a judge is contracted to judge multiple classes the maximum number of entries will not exceed 30.
- (v) Novice plus Community Companion Dog, and Utility plus Utility Dog Excellent are to be regarded as multiple classes.
- (vi) At an evening trial: The number of exhibits to be judged is to be estimated so that the trial and presentations are concluded prior to 12 midnight..

20.1C At a Rally Trial

Present Regulation Part 11 Show Section 20 Part 20.1C

- (i) Where judging one Class a maximum of 70 exhibits
- (ii) Where judging two classes a maximum of 60 exhibits
- (iii) Where judging three classes a maximum of 50 exhibits
- (iv) Where judging a combination of Obedience and Rally Obedience classes a maximum of 30 dogs
- (v) At an evening trial: the number of exhibits to be judged is to be estimated so that the trial and presentations are concluded prior to 12 midnight
