# 10.6 Decisions v Recommendations

The President advised the meeting that at a recent meeting between the President, Senior Vice President, Operations Manager and Company Secretary, the decision of the Board at the Strategic Planning meeting late last year, ie, to allow DOGS NSW Committees to make "decisions" instead of "recommendations" was reversed by the President and the Senior Vice President at that meeting.

The rationale for the reversing of the decision was that the RNSWCC Articles of Association, Article 48(a), states:-

# 48(a) The Board of Directors may, by resolution, delegate to one or more committees (consisting of such person or persons as the Board of Directors thinks fit) the exercise of such of the functions of the Board of Directors as are specified in the resolution, other than this power of delegation.

and, therefore, as a specific resolution had not been made by the Board to delegate decisions to DOGS NSW Committees, this decision was not enforceable.
