Ms Griffiths advised the meeting as follows:-

- Maximum number of sheep is 100, however, it may not be necessary to have that many, maybe 80-85 depending on schedules and trials. Managing 100 sheep is on these grounds is achievable.
 The Association is committeed to moving the sheep around to suit other bookings.
- The Association has appointed a Committee to manage the sheep and that Committee will take care of all worming, flea treatments, etc, and will cover those costs as well as food and supplements.
- Sheep will be rolled over at Spring time/end of training not all to be sold, just a few
- The Association is aware we are due for a very hot summer, however, there are some good patches of grass coming through now
- The appointed Committee will deal with any sick sheep. Jessica Campton is the Head Stock Manager, she has a University degree in animal welfare and has implemented a livestock app which allows for unlimited users and records tag numbers and any treatment to be diarised and logged with a report at the end of each month. The Association holds the welfare of the sheep as paramount.
- Other Clubs will have the same level of access to the sheep as previously, ie, through the DOGS
 NSW Booking System with all Trials being approved by the Sporting Committee.
- The Association currently runs training every Saturday and are currently investigating expanding this to Sundays. The Association is willing to work as a team to ensure no-one is disadvantgaged.
- The appointed Committee, made up of Jessica Campton, Josie Kimpton and Anne Wherry, will
 be responsible for notifying clubs of instances where it is necessary to cancel training due to
 issues such sheep needing treatment.
- Ms Griffiths explained to the Board the differences between Three Sheep Trials and Dogs Australia Herding Trials in respect of the running of the sheep.
- The Operations Manager sought confirmation as to the ownership of the sheep and Ms Griffiths advised that the Association will manage the sheep between now and the end of the Herding season (February 2023) at which time it will then purchase the sheep from DOGS NSW.
- Regular monthly reports will be provided to the Board via the Sporting Committee Minutes (via the DOGS NSW Herding Working Party).
