#### **APPENDIX**

#### **RING EQUIPMENT:**

General: The ring equipment comprises the judge/stewards table, card writer's table (if provided), hand washing basin with soap and towel, or disposable antibacterial wipes, pooper-scooper, and appropriate disposal container (or any other appropriate disposal method i.e. disposable bags) and any shelter provided in the ring for judges, stewards and/or exhibitors. Start peg/marker, Markers.

**OPEN Ring:** Solid Jump, Broad Jump, Markers

**UTILITY DOG Ring:** Solid Jump, Bar Jump, Prescribed Area (BOX), Scent Discrimination Mat, Markers

**UTILITY DOG EXCELLENT Ring:** 4 Cones, Markers

**RALLY Rings:** Signs, Numbered Station holders, Markers, Solid, Bar or Broad Jumps as required

**RING Sizes:** 

OBEDIENCE/RALLY: Minimum 45m x 15m No less than 30m x 15m

Exhibit Lapel Cards: Clearly legible exhibit number.
