 - emphasising that animal welfare is DOGS NSW prime concern
 - DOGS NSW is a self-regulating, registration body at no cost to the Government
 - DOGS NSW is nationally recognised in accordance with our written submission

The President urged the Councillors to consider their Policy in Clause 7.6: Exemptions to the Policy, being that DOGS NSW members should be exempt. The outcome that was verbally advised was that the vote was 8-2 for the number to be 4 dogs not 3 dogs per property (being that originally it was 4) and that Council would adopt the clause 7.6.

It was pleasing to note that this Council seemed to listen to the submissions put forward by ratepayers and an organisation such as DOGS NSW. Deputy Mayor Kelly Marsh was not in support of recommending a number and is happy to communicate with DOGS NSW further down the track with a view to reviewing this "Policy" if it is not working. Therefore, at this stage the Policy is only a guideline which is a good result for DOGS NSW.

Notwithstanding that, it was extremely disappointing to note only seven (7) people attended the meeting representing DOGS NSW membership.

- The identity of some members may not be consistent with their legal identity, this may pose a potential issue when they apply for the breeder discount on lifetime registration at their Local Council.

Directors sought clarification of the proposal by the Government to introduce licensing for breeders.
