- All works submitted must be the **original work** of the artist or photographer.
- Artwork must be labelled and be suitably prepared for display and hanging.
- The committee reserves the right to refuse entries deemed unsuitable or unsafe.
- Artists are responsible for arranging their own insurance and transport of artworks.
