Professor of Parasitology at the University of Queensland, St Lucia, Brisbane, Professor Barker has been studying ticks and other ectoparasites at the University of Queensland in Brisbane, Australia, for over 25 years.

Recent and current activities include:

(i) a monograph (670 pages), with his wife Dayana on the “Ticks of Australasia”; and
(ii) research directed to ensuring supply of Australian paralysis ticks (*Ixodes holocyclus*) for the production of tick anti-sera and new and improved immunological therapeutics to treat tick-paralysis in dogs.

The Seminar will cover the following topics:

- The Australian Eastern paralysis tick (how it ticks) and other ticks.
- Effects of paralysis tick toxin – short and long term.
- Current Treatment.
- Research work being conducted at the University of Queensland (funded by DQ).
- Warning Signs and When to Seek Help

Would you like to be paid to teach children about responsible pet ownership and behaving safely around dogs?

Do you own a happy, healthy, sociable dog between 18 months - 8 years?

The Responsible Pet Ownership education program is now recruiting Pet Educators in:

NSW - Sutherland Shire, Northern Beaches, Ryde, Waverley, Canterbury Bankstown, Canada Bay, Parramatta, Cumberland, Fairfield, Georges River, Inner West, Lane Cove, Mosman, North Sydney, Shellharbour, Shoalhaven, Kiama, Strathfield, Hunters Hill, Hornsby, Willoughby, Woollahra

The program's Pet Educators visit kindergartens and schools with their dog to give a short presentation to children about dog safety.

To be eligible to apply, you must own a happy, healthy dog that is 18 months to 8 years old, that resides with you for at least 1 year, and enjoys socialising with children. Your dog will need to pass our suitability test.

The Responsible Pet Ownership education program is provided by the Victorian Government and NSW Government. Successful candidates will be employed in their residing state, by the program's contracted staffing and payroll Provider, Randstad Recruitment as temporary labour hire. Training will be provided (for you and your dog), support and learning opportunities. Hours are during the school terms and are flexible.
